Uniform Policy

Expectations

Students are required to wear their formal school uniform each day, including while travelling to and from school. The only exception is for designated sport days.

Hats

It is compulsory for all students to own a school hat. St Peter's encourages sun safety for all students. For activities where students are exposed directly to the sun such as sporting activities and play on the oval, hats must be worn.

Bags

All new students are required to use the St Peter's school bag beginning in 2026. Existing students may continue using their current school bags until a replacement is needed. When a new bag is purchased, it must be the approved St Peter's school bag.

Shoes & Socks

- ONLY Black leather, vinyl lace up, sports or Velcro shoes that cover the whole foot and have no other colours are the only shoes to be worn at St Peter's
- Boots, Dunlop volleys, Skate Shoes, Mary Janes and girls Tbar are not permitted

Nail Polish

Coloured nail polish is not permitted as part of the school uniform.

Jewellery & Accessories

Acceptable jewellery:

- A small necklace with a small cross.
- Only ONE set of gold or silver stud earrings are permitted to be worn in the lower lobe.
- A wristwatch or smart watch is permitted, however, if the smart watch has internet capabilities the student MUST hand this into the teacher at the start of the school day and collect at the end of the school day.



Unacceptable jewellery:

- No coloured stones or decorative earrings are permitted.

- Multiple sets of earrings are not to be worn.
- Earrings in the upper lobe of the ear are not permitted.
- Rubber coloured wrist band are not to be worn.
- No shell or rope style necklaces, anklets or wristbands to be worn.
- Bangles are not to be worn and parents MUST seek approval from leadership regarding permission to wear.
- No nose piercings to be worn.



Hair

- Hair is to be kept clean, brushed, neat and of one's natural hair colour.
- A suitable fringe length is one which is out of the eyes of the student and is above the eyebrows.
- Hair, collar length or longer, must be tied back.
- Students may wear ribbons, small bows, hairbands, scrunchies and elastic bands in the school colours (blue, white and gold/yellow) or a neutral colour (black) on normal school days and house colours (red, blue, green or yellow) on interhouse carnival days (Swimming, Athletics, Cross Country).
- Jojo bows are not permitted to be worn.
- School hats must be able to be worn securely with the hairstyle.
- In trend hairstyles such as undercuts, cuts below gauge 2, stencil cuts, tracks, mullets and rats tails are not permitted. (NOTE: Comb over fades fall into the undercut group – very short on the sides with a definite part cut in on the side and long sweeping hair over the top).

Swimming Uniform

All students will have swimming lessons at St Peter's Aquatic Centre during the school year.

Swimming Uniform includes:

- Unisex swim short
- Girls' full piece
- Rash shirt - which is compulsory for all students

St Peter's swim wear is compulsory for all students, including caps and swim bag.



The wearing of the school uniform promotes pride in both the school and in the children themselves. Parents are encouraged to check that their children are wearing the correct school uniform prior to their departure for school.

Swimming caps and swimming bags are available in the House Colours.
